a.3 strand wall knot

- b.4 strand wall knot
- c.3 plait braid with burned end
- d.4 plait flat braid with burned end
- e.4 plait round braid with a wall knot tied on one end
- f.4 plait flat braid with a 3 plait split out and back in
- g.3 completed articles of your choice
