## Exhibit Guidelines

Exhibits should be made according to project book patterns.

- Quick Sack
  - Medium to heavy woven fabric
  - Lined
  - Shoelace, ribbon, or nylon cord 30"
- Jumbo Garment Bag
  - Medium to Heavy woven fabric
  - two zippers
  - 3 handles
  - Any length
- Handy Duffle Bag
  - Medium to heavy woven fabric
  - 1" webbing, ribbon, or durable braid straps
  - 1 zipper
  - 19" with a pocket on each side between straps
- Super Duffle Bag
  - Medium to heavy woven fabric
  - 1" webbing, ribbon, or durable braid straps
  - 1 zipper
  - 29" with a pocket on each side between straps
