## Exhibit Guidelines

Sam the slinky snake:

 the head connected to the tirst section with two eyelets 1 1/2" in from the outside

 first and second section connected with two large snaps 1 1/2" in from the outside edge

 second and third section connected with self closing tape (velcro) 2 1/2" inches

 third section and the tail are attached with two buttons 1 1/2" in from the outside edge

 Skirt and Top, Vest & skirt/pants, Top & skirt/pants, or Jumper & Top with the following quidelines

 Pattern of choice using woven fabric. Must include 3 of the following:

· Collar without a band

Faced neckline

Pockets

 Interfacing in front placket/collar/facing

Buttons and holes

NO ZIPPER
