Project Overview

The Fashion Magic: Wardrobe Planning project will help Senior 4-H members learn to customize their clothing and select clothing that they enjoy wearing. This is an entry-level project and should be completed before advancing to the other units.

Key Learning Topics

- How to select clothing that is best for you.
- How to keep an inventory of your clothing.
- How to mix and match clothing/accessories to make the most of your wardrobe.
- How to evaluate your clothing needs and desires.
- How to get the most out of money you spend for clothing.

Expanding the Project

- Participate in Fashion Magic at State Conference
- Serve on a planning committee to assist with a club, county, or area clothing event.
- Write a newspaper or newsletter article about clothing or a clothing related topic.
- Serve as a project teen leader and help members with their clothing project.
- Organize a clothing and shoe drive for a homeless shelter, nursing home, abuse center, or other organization
