Quilting has made a comeback. It can be a form of art or just a snuggle companion at your best friend's sleepover or a celebration of your favorite sport, colors or pet. Quilting is fun and creative. Quilting is not just for grannies, aunts and moms. Everyone seems to be quilting and so can you!

This project is designed for anyone from the beginning quilter to those of you with more experience. Included in the book are four styles of quilts and throws including quick and easy, rag, rail fence, and nine patch. Quilts and methods of completing them are in order of their difficulty. It is our suggestion that you start at the beginning and work your way up. Accompanying each quilt/throw are instructions for matching pillow cases or pillows.

In this project you will:

- Learn basic sewing skills.
- Learn basic quilting tools and quilting skills.
- Learn to combine fabric colors and patterns for pleasing combinations.
- Create unique one of a kind quilts.

As you develop your quilting skills, you may:

- Want to teach others how to sew.
- Make items to give to others.
- Sell items you make to earn money.
- Give talks or presentations about quilting to your club or other groups.
- Enter quilt shows.
- Enter/assist with achievement days and county fairs.
