Objectives:

To introduce you to the fundamentals of the art of shooting a rifle; to teach shooting safety and good sportsmanship, to teach an appreciation for the outdoors.

- New Mexico 4-H Rifle Greentop 400.F-38 (R-18)
- New Mexico 4-H Shooting Sports Greentop 400.F-2 (R-18)

Suggested tips for successful project completion:

- Review the project book, record sheet and greentop before preparing speeches, workshops or demonstrations.
- Make a check list to complete as you work this project.
- Participate in county, state and regional fairs.
- Enter project materials or demonstrations in the county, district or state contests.
- For the completion of the project, complete the record sheet and turn in a county record book to your local Extension Agent.

Ideas for talks and posters

- Gun safety/Parts of a rifle.
- History of rifles.

Suggested Activities:

- Give demonstrations or illustrated talks.
- Set up practice sessions with other 4-Hers enrolled in the rifle project.
- Talk to older 4-Hers on ways to improve posture and overall shooting performance.
- Attend a shooting competition hosted by a gun club in your area.
- Take a First Aid course to increase your awareness of safety.
- Register for a Hunter's Education Course through the New Mexico Game and Fish Department to develop greater awareness of safety and knowledge.
- Be an assistant to younger 4-H rifle shooters.
