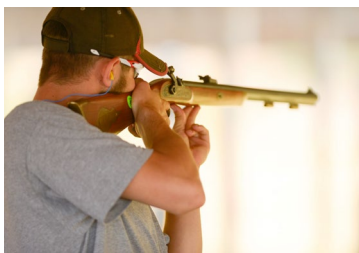




NM 4-H Shooting Sports Greentop

Objectives:

To teach sportsmanship and shooting sports safety while developing an appreciation for the sport and outdoors. While developing techniques, this project also allows 4-H'ers and their families, friends, and club to learn skills together.

Materials Included in this project:

- Record Form 300.A-7
- New Mexico 4-H Shooting Sports Greentop 400.F-2 (R-18)

Suggested tips for successful project completion:

- Review the project book, record sheet and greentop before preparing speeches, workshops or demonstrations.
- Make a check list to complete as you work this project.
- Participate in county, state and regional fairs.
- Enter project materials or demonstrations in the county, district or state contests.
- Register for a Hunter's Education Course through the New Mexico Game and Fish Department. to develop greater awareness of safety and knowledge of the sport
- For the completion of the project, complete the record sheet and turn in a county record book to your local Extension Agent.

Suggested Activities:

- Give demonstrations or illustrated talks.
- Set up practice sessions with other 4-Hers enrolled in the shooting sports projects.
- Attend a shooting competition hosted by a local gun club.
- Take a First Aid course to increase your awareness of safety.
- Speak to other organizations on the safety involved in shooting sports.
- Volunteer at a local gun club.
- Help teach younger 4-H pistol shooters.
- Attend the Youth Hunter Education Challenge competition.
