Suggested tips for successful project completion:

- Review the project book, record sheet and greentop before preparing speeches, workshops or demonstration.
- Make a check list to complete as you work this project.
- Participate in county, state and regional fairs.
- Enter project materials or demonstrations in the county, district or state contests.
- For the completion of the project, complete the record sheet and turn in a county record book to your local Extension Agent

Ideas for talks and posters:

- Boat safety.
- Fish senses and how to use that to your advantage when fishing.
- Construct an artificial fly or lure crafted and describe information on what fish and conditions it is designed for and how to use the tackle properly.

Suggested Activities:

- Give demonstrations or illustrated talks.
- Exhibit posters at county, regional or state fairs.
- Volunteer to clean a habitat like a lake or riverbank.
- Give a prepared speech or demonstration about the importance of aquatic resources to your club or school.
- Attend events to listen to experts in the field.
- Help others prepare a speech or demonstration about Sport Fishing.
