- Identifying waterfowl.
- Waterfowl migration.

Suggested Activities:

- Construct a nesting box for ducks.
- Give demonstrations or illustrated talks.
- Exhibit posters at county, regional or state fairs.
- Volunteer to clean a waterfowl habitat.
- Give a prepared speech or demonstration about the importance of waterfowl to your club or school.
- Attend events to listen to experts in the field.
- Help others prepare a speech or demonstration about wildlife.
